The School of Humanities and Media Studies at Högskolan Dalarna offers a great number of high-quality language courses, from the beginner to the advanced level, as individual courses or within a programme. You can study a wide variety of languages via internet or on campus including English, Italian, Spanish, Swedish, German, French, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, Arabic, and Chinese.

Full-time study is equivalent to 30 Higher Education Credits per term.

We also offer customized language courses for companies and public agencies.

### Internet-based courses

Wherever you may be in the world, you can study languages with us. All you need is access to a computer with a broadband connection. Since we offer technical support, you don't need to be a computer genius. We use a learning platform called Fronter where you will find your study materials, hand in your course work, chat with your classmates and much more. Our seminars take place online and for this you need a headset with a microphone and a camera. Studying via internet doesn't mean that you study alone! The technology makes continuous communication possible between students and teachers and among student groups, which contributes to the courses' high quality.

### On-campus courses

Högskolan Dalarna is an international meeting place. Teachers from all over the world enrich the teaching quality and provide rewarding cultural interactions and communication in a foreign language. Every year many international

### Program

#### Foundation Year of English for Academic Purpose 60 HEC/1 year

The aim of the foundation year is to complement the student's previous education at secondary school, and to fulfil the specific requirements of English for a wide range of courses and programmes at university level. The year will also introduce the student to university study.

#### Bachelor Programme in English - Language, Literature and Culture, 180 HEC/3 year
