

How do I proceed towards a bachelor's degree?

Total 165 credits, 90 credits of Chinese which must include Course A and Course B, and 3 courses from Course C to Course F.

Term 6

Note:

1. It is the students' responsibility to apply for courses or course packages every term via antagning.se or universityadmissions.se.
2. Students can study part-time towards a BA degree in Chinese. However, courses in the first 60 credits have evening seminars, all other courses only have day-time seminars.

- **If you have prior knowledge of Chinese language, you should have your knowledge assessed to apply for courses that fit your Chinese proficiency level.**

Documentation for previous studies

If you have documentation (transcript and/or certificate) for Chinese courses studied outside Sweden, please submit the documentation when applying for courses via antagning.se or universityadmissions.se.

Placement test

If you have NO documentation for your prior knowledge of Chinese, you can complete an online placement test with us. Please contact support@du.se about the placement test. However, all students who plan to apply for the BA thesis course must fulfil the course prerequisites mentioned above.
