Courses

Students will enroll in the equivalent of 30 ETS credits, 12-15 credit hours, or four to five courses. Most U.S. courses are 3 credit hours and meet for 3 hours each week over 16 weeks. Nine credit hours (U.S.) must be in the College of Education. Courses may be arranged outside the College, but cannot be guaranteed. - Fully furnished apartment – one or two bedrooms

- Housing is US \$3,500 for 18 weeks
- Refundable deposit US \$300

Students under 21 years of age:

- Furnished apartment/dormitory room
- On TCU campus
- Apartments/Dormitory shared with another student
- Housing is US \$4,215-\$4,425 plus purchase of meal plan US \$900 (prices as of Fall 2019)

Other Information

Students must apply for a J1 Visa, provide proof of medical insurance and pay an application processing fee of US \$50.

Application Process

- ETEN Liaisons contact TCU's ETEN ECO with names of interested students.
- Students complete a nomination survey from TCU's College of Education.
- Students notified of acceptance and asked to provide additional information. TCU can accommodate 12 students per semester.
