

Course Syllabus

Intercultural Literature Studies: Fiction in its Original Language 7.5 Credits*, Second Cycle

Learning Outcomes

On completion of the course, students will be able to:

- perform close readings of complex literary texts in the original in a foreign language of their own choosing
- with good stylistic skills write critically elaborate reviews of literary works
- describe in detail the historical, social and biographical context of a number of literary works.

Course Content

In the course, students read a selection of fictional texts in their original language of publication. Students choose the texts in consultation with the teacher. These texts must be in a language that is not the students' mother tongue, they must be relevant to the students' plans for their thesis, and they must be relatively complex. The course includes the study of the context of the texts, and students present their interpretations of the texts both orally and in writing.

Assessment

Active participation in seminars, oral presentations and written assignments.

Forms of Study

Obligatory seminars. The language of instruction is English.
