African Studies: Elaborated Research Plan 1 Credits*, Second Cycle Level 1

Learning Outcomes

After completion of the course the student shall be able to:

- determine a well defined specific area of research within the field of African Studies
- present an overview of relevant and contemporary research associated with the chosen area of research
- present a preliminary objective and analytical questions for a future master thesis/research paper
- present a second draft research overview.

Course Content

The student will work on developing a previously presented and approved Draft Research Proposal. This will comprise a preliminary definition of a specific area of research, a presentation of an overview of the current state of research as well as the preliminary objective, questions and outline of the future research project.

Assessment

Students are assessed through active participation in seminars, the presentation of the developed research proposal and their formulation of constructive and systematic critique of other students' proposals.

Forms of Study


The course is taught through seminars. All teaching is in English.
