

## Course Syllabus

### **African Studies: Developing the Research Proposal 1 Credits\*, Second Cycle Level 1**

#### **Learning Outcomes**

After completion of the course the student shall be able to:

- define a draft of a specific area of research within the field of African Studies
- present a short overview of contemporary research associated with the chosen area of research
- present a preliminary objective and tentative analytical questions for his/her own research project.

#### **Course Content**

The student will work on developing a smaller draft for a research proposal. This will comprise a preliminary definition of a specific area of research, a presentation of an overview of the relevant state of research as well as the preliminary objective, questions and outline of the future research project.

#### **Assessment**

Students are examined through the assessment of active participation in seminars and the presentation of the research proposal.

#### **Forms of Study**

Seminars, where the language of instruction is English.

#### **Grades**

The Swedish grades A–F.

#### **Prerequisites**

Bachelor Degree of 180 credits in the field of Humanities, Social Sciences or Education and English 6. No knowledge of Swedish is required.
