

## **Course Syllabus**

# African Studies: Rethinking African Studies 7 Credits\*, Second Cycle Level 2

### Learning Outcomes

The overall aim of the course is to prepare the student for the writing of a master degree thesis in African Studies. Upon completion of the course, the student shall be able to:

- examine, with a high degree of independence, current epistemological and methodological assumptions of African Studies
- identify contemporary academic tendencies within the field
- critically examine relations within the global context of certain African states and regions.

### **Course Content**

The course deals with the debate about the function that academic studies and research about Africa have in the meeting with post-colonial African societies and contemporary global challenges. An example of questions to be discussed is: In what way can African Studies be regarded in relation to the disciplinary origins of the field?

### Assessment

The course is examined by written papers and oral presentations.

### Forms of Study

The course normally consists of seminars. Depending on the number of students enrolled, the course may be taught as an independent study course. All teaching is conducted in English.

### Grades

The Swedish grades A-F.

### Prerequisites

Bachelor degree 180 credits and the courses African Studies: Dynamics of African Societies 12 credits, African Studies: Religion and Politics in African Societies 9 credits, African Studies: Education and Change in African Societies 8 credits, African Studies: Developing the Research Proposal 1 credit, and African Studies: Elaborate Research Plan 1 credit
