### **Research Methods in Global Sexual, Reproductive Health 7.5 Credits\*, Second Cycle**

#### **Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the course, students will be able to:

- demonstrate an ability to independently and systematically search for relevant scientific articles to identify research areas and formulate questions relevant to research in the field
- analyse and examine the quality of studies conducted on the basis of both quantitative and qualitative methods
- apply basic skills in the design of studies, data generation and analysis of qualitative and quantitative research
- argue for the use of ethical principles in various research situations.

Students will study research methods and ethics in the research process relevant to the research field of global sexual and reproductive health and rights.

Written assignments and seminars.
