

# **Course Syllabus**

### French: Culture and Society I 7.5 Credits\*, First Cycle

#### Learning Outcomes

On completion of the course students shall, in French, be able to:

- describe the geographical aspects and features of France
- explain the concept of "la francophonie" and its significance
- describe and discuss some important aspects of culture and politics in contemporary French society
- describe and discuss, both oral and in writing, topics relating to France and the French-speaking world.

#### **Course Content**

The course includes a study of French geography and society. Some aspects of cultural and social conditions in France and the French-speaking world are covered. The concept "la francophonie" is analyzed and discussed.

#### Assessment

Continuous assessment through active participation in seminars, assignments and oral presentations.

#### Forms of Study

Teaching is conducted through online seminars in which students are expected to participate actively. Instruction is in French.

#### Grades

The Swedish grades U-VG.

To achieve the grade of VG for the whole course, VG is required in module 2.

Reporting of grades: Module 1: Oral presentation - 3 cr Module 2: Written presentation - 4.5 cr

General entry requirements and French 3, English 6. No knowledge of Swedish is required
