Project Work Outdoor 7.5 Credits, First Cycle

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students will be able to:

- * present and argue for a theoretically linked project plan that contains both a financial budget and a timetable
- * independently initiate, plan, lead, implement and present an advanced experience production project for a defined target group in written form
- * report and critically relate to the education within Experience production - sports, health and outdoor and professional experience production.

Course Content

The course covers both theoretical and practical aspects of carrying out project work within experience production on one's own initiative.

Assessment

- Examining seminar
- Oral presentation
- Written project plan
