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# **Course Syllabus**

# Comparative Political Systems 7.5 Credits\*, First Cycle Level 1

#### Learning Outcomes

On completion of the course, the student shall be able to:

- demonstrate basic knowledge of political systems in different countries,
- demonstrate understanding of different institutional features such as federal and unitary states, parliamentarism and presidentialism, proportional and majority election systems, democratic and non-democratic systems,
- demonstrate basic knowledge of comparative method and how systematic comparisons between countries can be conducted.

#### **Course Content**

The course deals with different ways of structuring political systems, how states function, as well as how states compare with each other. A review of the major concepts, theories and models of interpretation of the different political systems will be carried out. Key concepts are political institutions, democratic and non-democratic regimes, democratisation processes, and political culture. An important element of the course is a study of the Swedish political system when viewed beside the political systems of other countries.

#### Assessment

Written take-home examination, written and oral presentations and active participation of the student during seminars.

#### Forms of Study

Lectures and mandatory seminars.
