Sociocultural conditions influence reproductive health, as well as children's living conditions and health. From an international perspective, women often have a vulnerable position with limited power and significant risks associated with pregnancy and childbirth. Children and youth's health problems varies greatly depending on age. The infancy years are the most vulnerable period, and infants requiring neonatal care constitute a particularly vulnerable group.
